Theme 1 (Identity and Culture)

- 1. Relationships, Family and Friends
 - Family, pets, appearance, nationality, dates, numbers, relationships.

2. Free Time

3. Festivals

 Celebrations, typical Spanish/French festivals, Easter, Christmas, birthdays

4. Social Networking

Mobile technology, advantages and disadvantages, usage.

<u>Theme 2 (Local, national, international ad global areas of interest).</u>

- 1. Home Town, Region and Neighbourhood
 - House, location, amenities, directions, tickets for transport & travel.

2. Environment and social Issues

 Weather & seasons, environment, pollution problems, advantages & disadvantages, recycling.

3. Holiday and Travel

 Location, travel, complaints, transport, weather, opinions, reservations, info about an area, hotels, accommodation, travel, restaurants, holiday activities, local customs and festivals and food specialities.

- 1. Education Post-16
 - Future plans, jobs, apprenticeships,

 School rules, instructions, descriptions, subjects & opinions, facilities, uniform, technology.

Ways I could revise:

- Past papers
- Listenings on websites (see above) and on school shared area.
- Read French/ Spanish headlines (online papers).
- Look at previously done past papers & redo.
- Highlight key vocab that don't know.
- Get someone to do vocab tests with you.
- Create own games or quizlets/kahoots.
- Create mini dictionary of unknown words.
- Post-It notes across bedroom, fridge etc.
- Colour code tenses etc.
- Use revision guide activities well.
- Listen to Spanish/French TV/Radio.
- Create word families.
- Write 1st letters & gap fills.
- Look, cover, write, check.
- Record words onto phone and listen to them.
- Find songs.
- Make flashcards.
- Teach vocabulary to someone else in the family.
- Re do past papers under timed conditions.
- Speaking and Writing booklets
- French / Spanish verb booklets
