Suggested Topics I Should Revise	Ways I could revise:
<p>A01</p> <p>Research artists and themes relating to the exam question chosen. Research the meaning of the artist's work, their style, content, method, techniques and use of colour.</p>	<p>A01</p> <p>Print out artist's images to stick on your research sheet or in your sketchbook.</p> <p>Pick out key areas from the images to draw from on the same page.</p> <p>Use tracing techniques, cutting images in half and drawing one of the halves. Use tracing paper and add colour to the tracing paper. Use the light box.</p> <p>Use a variety of materials, selecting the ones that will best represent the artist's technique and style.</p> <p>Annotate your sheets with information about the artist's work including their style, method, techniques, use of colour and meaning.</p>

Experiment, refine and modify your work.

Use a variety of materials and techniques to experiment with using your gathered images.

Experiment to see the different effects that can be achieved through using different colours, photo manipulation and scale.

Create a range of compositions to develop the best possible arrangement for your finale piece. This could be achieved through the use of photocopied images and collage.

Practice your final exam piece on a smaller scale before your exam.

A03

Gather observations and insights through observational drawings and photography.

Draw from objects that relate to your chosen question.

Photograph objects that relate to your chosen question.

A02

Use methods and techniques you have used before to experiment with, these could be:

- Monoprinting,
- Poly print,
- Sgraffito,
- Working on top of photocopies,
- Tracing paper paintings,
- Acrylic painting on laminate sheets,
- Collage.

Photocopy experimental images to create collaged compositions.

A03

Draw images and objects that relate to the artist's images studied in A01.

Use a variety of methods and materials to record images. These could be ;

- Pencil,
- Pen wash,
- Ink,
- Crosshatching,
- Oil pastel,
- Water colour painting,
- Acrylic painting.

Use different paper surfaces on which to draw.

Mount photographs.
