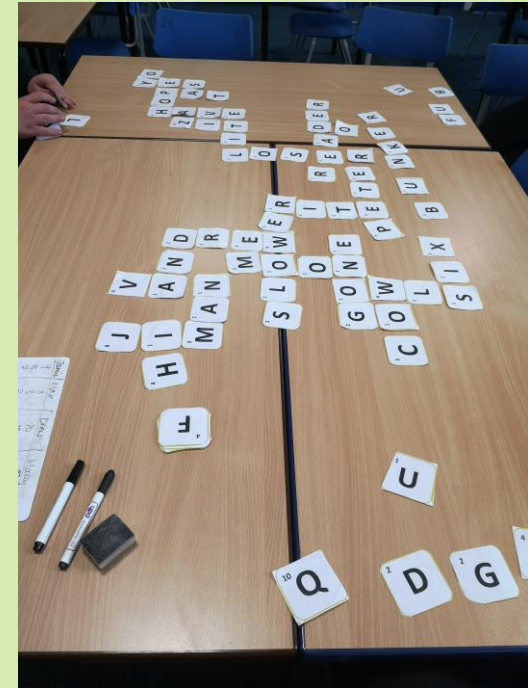

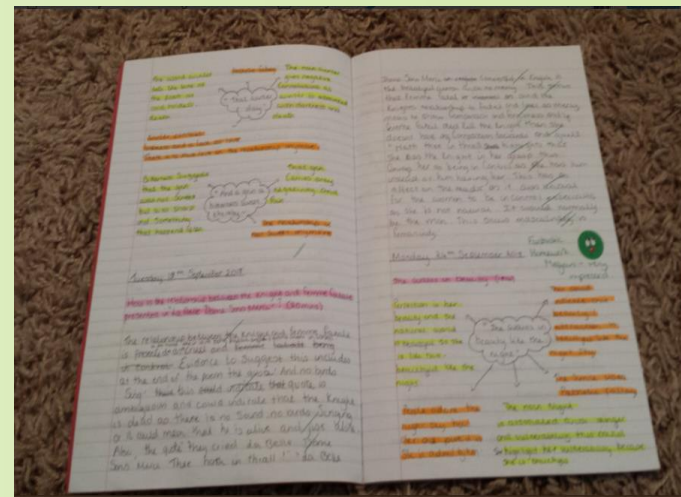
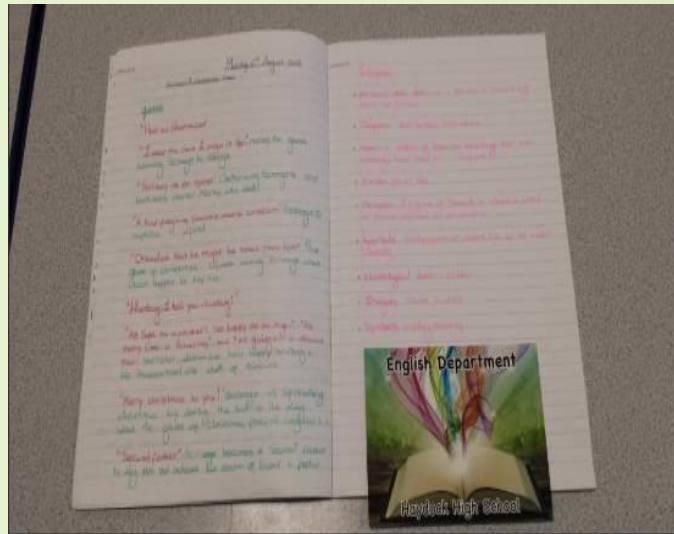
Science – Nominated by Mrs Chang

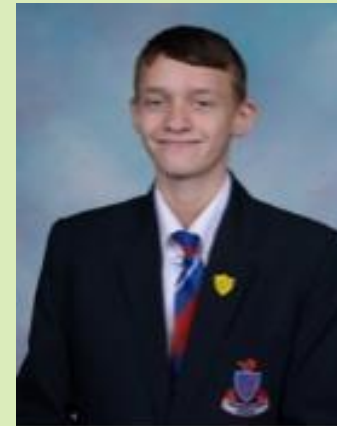
Religion and Ethics – Nominated by Miss Edwards
