



## Data Glossary

### Progress Report

- the report sent home to parents/carers detailing the OPT, assessment grade, current grade and AtL.

### Pathway

- the way of defining a set of minimum outstanding progress targets (OPTs) based on Key Stage 2 starting point. These targets map out an estimated journey of progress across five years to above national expectation.

### Outstanding Progress Target (OPT)

- the target established from the relevant point on pathway progress journey

### Data Trawl

- the term used to define the process of harvesting information about students' grades and AtLs.

### Attitudes to Learning (AtL)

- the attitudes displayed by students in lessons in relation to preparation and organisation, effort and attitude, behaviour and homework. AtLs are awarded on a scale of 1 – 5 (see overleaf)

### Assessment Grade

- this is the grade obtained in assessment activity during their assessment point

### Current Grade

- this is the grade that indicates where students are at this moment in time based upon their attitudes, skills, knowledge and work (classwork, assessments and homework) completed so far.
