



The Basics

Start

- Students will arrive on time

- Students will not eat in lesson
- Student will only drink in lesson with permission from the teacher

End

- Students will record homework correctly in their planners
- Students will only pack away with permission from the teacher
- Students will stand behind their chair until dismissed by their teacher
