Dear Parent/ Guardian/ Carer,

I am writing to remind you that school will break up for the summer at **3:00pm on Tuesday 23rd July**. School will reopen for the autumn term on **Wednesday 4th September at 8:40am**

I would like to remind parents that all advice about the school uniform and rules are on the website. All pupils must wear shoes as specified on the website. Can I please ask you to ensure that you buy your son/daughter the correct shoes during the summer holiday. No pupils are allowed to wear jewellery and therefore if pupils are considering piercings it is better to do so in the first week of the summer holiday so that they can be removed in time for school in September. Please can you also remind your son/daughter that pupils must not use mobile phones in school and if they wish to contact parents they must do so via student reception.

I am extremely pleased with the continued improvement in punctuality during this half term. Excellent attendance and punctuality are a key foundation to achievement and success at school and it is therefore essential that we equip the pupils with the necessary skills for future employment.
