Subject	Assessment Information
Art	This assessment will be the completion of students' final piece for their independent exam.
Spanish & French	This assessment will cover all four skills - listening, speaking, reading and writing. Students should be prepared to respond to both seen and unseen language.
	Assessments will involve:
	<ul> <li>Listening: students will listen and respond to what they hear and answer questions in both English and the Target Language.</li> <li>Speaking: students will complete a Roleplay, a Photo card and have a general</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Reading: students will read and respond to what they hear and answer questions in both English and the Target Language and complete a translation into English.</li> <li>Writing: students will have to write in the Target Language at their required level.         <ul> <li>Foundation: 40 words/90 words plus sentences translated into the Target Language.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Higher: 90 words/150 words plus a paragraph translated into the Target Language.</li> </ul>
Music	This assessment will be a Unit 1 –'The Music Industry' past paper.
	This assessment will 1 hour.
History	This assessment will be 1 hour and 45 minutes.
	The assessment will be based on 'Crime and Punishment and the historical environment – Whitechapel'.
	There will be a focus on:
	Workhouses and immigration in Whitechapel
	The nature of punishments and the definition of crimes from 1000 to 1700.
	The development of the police force and prison

Science	This assessment will be a full AQA paper 1. Students will sit a paper in Biology, chemistry and Physics, each 1hr 15min in duration.

	<ul> <li>genetic inheritance, including inherited conditions and predisposition to other conditions</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>ill health (acute and chronic)</li> <li>diet (balance, quality and amount)</li> <li>amount of exercise</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>substance use, including alcohol, nicotine, illegal drugs and misuse of prescribed drugs</li> <li>personal hygiene.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Social, emotional and cultural factors that can have positive or negative effects on health and wellbeing:</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>social interactions, e.g. supportive/unsupportive relationships, social integration/isolation</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>stress, e.g. work-related</li> <li>willingness to seek help or access services, e.g. influenced by culture, gender, education.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Economic factors that can have positive or negative effects on health and wellbeing:</li> <li>financial resources.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Environmental factors that can have positive or negative effects on health and wellbeing:</li> <li>environmental conditions, e.g. levels of pollution, noise</li> <li>housing, e.g. conditions, location.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The impact of life events relating to relationship changes and changes in life circumstances.</li> </ul>
