We are taking part in **#UniteTheUniforms for the @999Cenotaph** campaign. The aim of the campaign is to raise money to fund a national monument to honour our past, present and future NHS and emergency services - all roles to be represented, as frontline workers could not do their jobs without those behind the scenes. This event is a once in a lifetime opportunity to recognise and support the teams that have dedicated themselves to supporting individuals and communities across the country. On **Friday**, **3**rd **December**, numerous fundraising activities will take place in schools and workplaces across the country to support this campaign.
