Centre Assessed Grades for Year 10 Vocational Subjects (individual units) and GCSE Statistics

Due to the pandemic some exam boards have asked schools to provide them with the results of individual units or components that students would have completed during the Summer term. For Pearson Edexcel Courses, students are allowed one optional resubmission within a given time frame, to try and improve their grade in September - this will be discussed with each student individually in the new academic year.
