Visitors will queue outside on the junior yard ready for their appointment (similar to a supermarket system). The usual hand sanitiser and cleaning processes will be followed throughout the appointment and we ask that all, bar those exempt, wear a face covering whilst on site; this can be removed during your meeting.
